GRAY FAMILY OF BILLISTER

John Henry Gray, Chief Officer, *HMT Confield*. Torpedoed off Dover. Billister, North Nesting.

James Hunter Gray, Private, Machine-Gun Corps, Australian Imperial Force. He suffered a severe gunshot wound to the left forearm 6th July 1918.

Hugh Gray, Seaman-Gunner, R.N.R, *SS Blackheath*. Billister, North Nesting. He appears to have married but had no family and emigrated to New Zealand later in life where he died aged 72 at Wanganui.

Thomas Hunter Gray, Seaman, Merchant Service, SS Hysa. Billister, North Nesting.

Their parents were John Gray and Jane Hunter, Jane died two years after the birth of Thomas; she was 45. They had six sisters (although one died aged one and one died of tuberculosis aged 17) and one brother, William Hunter Gray, who was accidentally killed while in Colombo, Ceylon (Sri Lanka), aged 15.

William J Hunter, Private, 3rd Gordon Highlanders. Billister, North Nesting.

Peter W Hunter, Seaman, R.N.R., H.M. Minesweeper *Lynn*. Billister, North Nesting.

Their parents were Henry Hunter and Jacobina Leask. They had three sisters and three more brothers.

ROBERTSON FAMILY OF THE ARIE

William Robertson, Arie. Lance Corporal, 13th Infantry Battalion, Australian Army. Died 3rd May at Gallipoli, Turkey, aged 39.

Gilbert Scott Robertson, Arie. Thought to have died in WWI, possibly in the Bay of Biscay.

Their parents were Arthur Robertson and Grace Tait. They had two sisters, three half-sisters and three half-brothers.
